

- We want to prepare well and play well!
- Practice time on the instrument will be scheduled
- Performers should practice setting pistons quickly, so that our performance time is not spent on this necessary (but not very interesting) activity

We are looking for a person to join our music ministry who wishes to inspire through a variety of music styles.


